

## Don't freeze on pool care

WINTER pool maintenance is a must. Crystal Pools is an Australian owned and operated business which was established nearly 60 years ago.

"However, this is a false economy," he said. "Regular maintenance over the winter months will help to protect your asset." Mr Rothery said before closing the pool for winter it was important to give the pool and equipment a thorough clean.

"Scrub the tiles, walls and floor making sure you get into all the corners before giving the pool a thorough vacuum," he said.

He also recommended covering the pool. "Throughout winter we recommend you switch to a weekly maintenance schedule that includes checking water levels, running the filters and cleaning systems for a few hours each week, ensuring your water is correctly balanced and cleaning debris from the skimmer basket and surface," he said.

"If you are planning on installing a pool for next summer, you should be speaking to pool builders now," Mr Rothery said. "Construction times vary depending on a number of factors including council approval times and weather constraints."
